Illini Republicans' questions for the Black Students for Revolution Book Club

- 1. "Werner Foerster left behind a wife and two children. If one of those children were here today, what would you tell them?"
- 2. "Chesimard claims that she was shot in the gunfight with Foerster and Harper and was 'left there to die.' How does this match up with the fact that she was actually found four miles down the road from where the murder occurred?"
- 3. "Police found a book in Chesimard's car after her arrest which detailed potential BLA targets. Doesn't this offer further proof that she was a domestic terrorist who planned to kill again?"
- 4. "If Chesimard was targeted by police in NJ, how doe (sic) that explain that she also attempted two police officers four months prior in Queens?"
- 5. "Do you think it is fair that Chesimard was not convicted of the murder of Richard Nelson because of a technicality (they had waited too long to try her because they were busy charging her with Foerster's murder)?"
- 6. "Since fleeing to Cuba, Chesimard has become an outspoken supporter of the Castro regime. If she really was a brave revolutionary rather than an embittered terrorist, why would she make propaganda for a mass-murdering dictator?"
