Historic Win in Cunningham Township: The People Demand an End to U.S. Military Aid to Israel

Urbana IL – In a landmark community victory, Cunningham Township voters have spoken decisively in favor of ending U.S. military aid to Israel. The recently passed Cunningham Township Question 1 has garnered overwhelming support, marking a pivotal moment in the call for peace and an end to military support for Israel's actions in Palestine. With 70.09% voting "yes" and 29.91% opposed, the results highlight the township's strong stance, demanding that U.S. taxpayer funds no longer contribute to what voters identify as war crimes and apartheid.

This decisive, community-led movement shows the power of grassroots organizing and solidarity. The coalition that made this possible consists of a diverse group, including Muslim and Jewish residents, LGBTQIA individuals, and people across all political affiliations who are uniting for peace and justice. Their collaboration and shared vision are forging a broader anti-war movement, centered on safety, unity, and collective well-being.

As part of this historic movement, the community and media are invited to join a rally and press conference that will be held this Tuesday, November 12th 11:30am at the IMC. This gathering will further underscore the community's commitment to justice, peace, and solidarity with oppressed people worldwide.
