### Demonstrators hold AT&T accountable for contracts with DHS, CBP, and ICE

**November 16, 1:30pm to 2:30 pm**

**AT&T Store 1902 N. Prospect Avenue, Champaign**

*Corporation has and continues to profit from the mass detention and deportation machine*

**Champaign, Illinois** – Customers, churches, faith leaders, and community members are organizing a peaceful action at the AT&T store on North Prospect in Champaign. The purpose of this action is to call on the telecom giant to cancel its contracts with the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Customs and Border Patrol (CBP), and Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). National and statewide organizational partners, which include faith communities, will simultaneously hold actions across the state and the country, echoing this demand.

**WHAT:** Tell AT&T to end its contracts with ICE

**WHEN:** 1:30pm to 2:30pm CT, Sunday, November 16, 2025

**WHO:** Customers, churches, faith leaders, and community members

**WHERE:** AT&T –1902 N Prospect Ave., Champaign

**VISUALS:** Large, nonviolent crowd, signs, chants, and flyers for canvassing



With [\\$30.7 billion](#) in revenue in the third quarter of 2025 alone, AT&T does not need its 2024 or 2025 contracts with the Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Patrol, and Immigration and Customs Enforcement to remain profitable. Yet, the telecom giant is choosing to both collect money from customers who are in the crosshairs and line its pockets with public dollars from DHS, CBP, and ICE. These agents are often *masked, unidentifiable, and operating without warrants* as they terrorize members of the public in communities across Illinois.
