Fatal Traffic Crash Investigation

UPDATE: Pedestrian Succumbs to Injuries After Urbana Crash

The following is an update to the informational release from this morning's traffic crash at Green Street and Mathews Avenue.

The Urbana Police Department has confirmed that the pedestrian who was struck during the crash has died as a result of injuries sustained in the incident. The individual was transported to Carle Hospital following the crash, where they later succumbed to their injuries.

The Urbana Police Department would like to extend its condolences to the friends and family of the victim of this incident.

The University of Illinois police officer involved in the crash was transported to Carle Hospital and treated for minor injuries.

The Urbana Police Department's Criminal Investigations Unit continues to lead the investigation. Police are still actively searching for the driver of the red Buick involved in the crash.

At this time, the names of the individuals involved are not being released.
