“Locally, No Kings 3 spotlights a community unified by concern for the Constitution and for one another,” Champaign County Indivisible co-lead Jeff Dougan said. “We’re sending a simple message: We don’t do dictators or kings in America.

“Would-be autocrats want us divided and afraid. Instead, we’re coming together, taking time to acknowledge what the last year has put us all through, and then using celebration as an act of resistance, complete with live music, a Statue of Liberty/Uncle Sam costume contest, and a spirited march through downtown Urbana.”

No Kings is a nonviolent movement that has mobilized millions — from over five million participants on June 14, 2025, to over seven million people on October 18, 2025 — and is growing as communities unite to reject authoritarian power grabs and defend freedom.
